

LBH – instructions for authors, Leipziger Tierärztekongress

1. Manuscript preparation

- **Word-document** (important: file extension **.doc/** - also with Macintosh!)
- **max. 10.000 characters**, incl. space characters
- True Type Font (e.g. Arial 12pt)
- **Bold** only for titles and headings
- *Italics* only for latin terms (incl. latin species names)

Order:

- o 1. **Title:** bold, capital letters only at the beginning and for names
- o 2. **Authors:** Forename Surname, authors separated by comma, if more than one institution: affiliation to institute marked with number following surname, e.g. Jörg R. Aschenbach¹ (no superscript number)
- o 3. **Institutions:** numeric order, separated by semicolon, e.g. 1Veterinär-Physiologisches Institut, Universität Leipzig
- o Country of non-German institutions in brackets, e.g. Paris (France)
- o 4. **Headings:** bold, capital letters only at the beginning and for names
- o 5. **Text:** british (Oxford) english, hyphenless justification, no indentions, only latin terms in italics, please use SI units
- o 6. **References:** see below
- o 7. **Contact adress:** Prenom Surname, title(s) of the responsible author, Institution, Email

Special characters / symbols, which cannot be reproduced with Arial Narrow (Font used for print) or Symbol: Mark with # at the beginning and the end with no space, e.g. #alpha# (the symbol will be inserted by the editorial staff).

Tables:

- **Maximum width 140 mm**, wider tables cannot be reproduced
- Use Word table editor, only single line frames, no special formats
- Title in the following format: **Table 1:** Overview of ...

Figures:

- **Never place figures into the text file**, use separate upload (see below)
- **maximum of two figures** per manuscript, only **.jpg** possible, max. size each 5 MB, 1800×1800 pixels
- No color reproduction possible, avoid gray shades (e.g. use hatching or other patterns)
- Place figure legend into text file: **Fig. 1:** Percentage of ...
- If you need more than two figures per manuscript please contact us

Please, cite references according **Vancouver Style** as proposed by International Committee of Medical Journal Editors (www.icmje.org).

Details are available via email (blauehefte@uni-leipzig.de).

- Text citation: references in order of appearance as numbers in brackets. Two ore more citations should be arranged in chronological order, separated by comma / hyphen. Place numbers before the punctuation mark.
e.g.: ...as described before (1,2). ...shown in numerous reports (1,3-6).

- **References:** in order of appearance in the text.

- Use „in press“ only for references accepted for publication
- More than six authors: list first six authors followed by et al.
- Use capital letters only at the beginning of the title / of names

Quality check:

All manuscripts will undergo a review by the Section Editor, who may ask other reviewers for expert opinions. If revision is requested, points raised by the Section Editor and/or reviewers need to be taken into consideration. Deviations of the suggestions need to be explained.
